We hope the information and map provided will assist you in negotiating the traffic easily and help you to find the various car parks within the town.

ENTERING FROM THE SOUTH M6 jct 36/A590/A591 & A6

Kirkland / Town Centre
 From A591 take the Kendal South exit – A6 (Milnthorpe Road). Turn right at the traffic lights at Romney Road for Lakes Leisure and Hospital.
 For Kirkland, Kendal’s cultural area and the Town Centre drive straight on into the one-way system, past the Parish Church on the right (Kirkland) and the Brewery Arts Centre on the left (Highgate). Kirkland and Highgate are only a short walk from the Town Centre and have a number of car parks, attractions and unique shops.
 The coach drop off point is on Highgate outside the Shakespeare Inn on the left-hand side.

ENTERING FROM THE NORTH EAST – M6 jct 37/A684

Stramongate / Town Centre
 Follow the A684 (Sedbergh Road) through to the roundabout at Kendal Railway Station. Turn left into Wildman Street, (you do not use the roundabout), and follow the one-way system round to the multi storey pay on exit car park and drop off point on Blackhall Road.

ENTERING FROM THE NORTH WEST – A591

Town Centre
 Follow signs for Town Centre A5284 (Windermere Road). Turn left into Sandes Avenue and at the second set of traffic lights turn right into Blackhall Road. Turn immediately right to access the multi storey pay on exit car park and drop off point on Blackhall Road. Alternatively follow the one-way system round for additional car parks and attractions.

ENTERING FROM THE NORTH – A6

Town Centre
 Follow the A6 (Shap Road) through to the roundabout at Kendal railway station. Go straight ahead at roundabout onto Wildman Street. Follow the one-way system round to the multi storey pay on exit car park and drop off point on Blackhall Road. Alternatively, follow the one-way system round for additional car parks and attractions.

PARKING INFORMATION

Disabled Parking
 Blue Badge holders can only park within the pedestrian zone before 11am or after 4pm, but there are many other Blue Badge spaces marked on the map which are available throughout the day. Blue Badge holders can park in any bay in all SLDC car parks for free.

Town Centre Coach Drop Off Points
 Shakespeare Inn on Highgate or the east side of Blackhall Road, opposite Kendal Bus Station.

Loading / Unloading
 No loading/unloading on Highgate, Stricklandgate, Market Place and Stramongate between 11am and 4pm, Monday to Friday and between 10am and 4pm Saturday and Sunday.

Cyclists
 Cycle park spaces are available around the town.
