Starting in January 2017 a good part of the site has been cleared and dug over and now grows **Potatoes, Leeks, Sweetcorn, Beans, Beetroots, Courgettes and Onions.**

With funding from the WG Edwards Foundation we have been able to replace the old shed with a brand new one and buy some new tools.

The Allotment could appeal to people who have an interest in **growing plants, being outdoors** and **trying something new.**

It might be of interest to people who have had an allotment in the past and who are finding it a bit too much to work a plot on their own. It's a very sociable activity with good chat and cups of tea and a friendly welcome.
