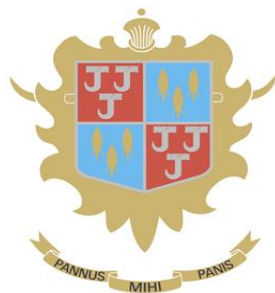

Kendal in Bloom – School's Challenge 2019



This Year's Theme Is Stories

This year, Kendal Town Council would like to encourage your school to create a space or project that is centred around 'Stories' and your interpretation of that theme. For example your gardening project could be linked to a particular favourite story, or perhaps the story of a famous person from history, or the story of the Kendal canal as it is 200 years since the canal that ran into Kendal was opened. The choice is limitless. We are happy for it to be linked with other school projects or with other areas of your curriculum. There is no strict criteria, we would like you to be creative and use your imagination to develop a project or space.

The Kendal in Bloom project is flexible, allowing the students to develop their own ideas and learn new things. The Mayor and a representative from the Kendal in Bloom Committee usually visit at the end of June to view your project. If your project has 'bloomed' by that point, it's no problem, just let them see photographs of the project at its best. If possible, a portfolio or slideshow of progress and ideas are really useful for them to view, but it isn't compulsory. This is your project and we would like you to have fun and enjoy it.

The Kendal in Bloom Committee are also offering a £20.00 gardening voucher to all schools who register to take part. The vouchers will be sent out shortly after the closing date of **Friday 29th March 2019**.

There will be a certificate and gardening vouchers for all entries. These will be presented at an evening of celebration to be held on **Thursday 19th September 2019** at Kendal Town Hall. If you would like to have your work on display at this event, please let me know and I can arrange for this to happen.

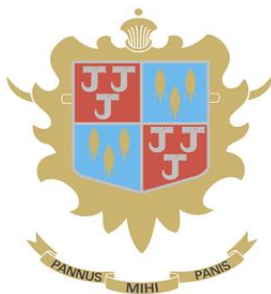
