8. Westmorland and Furness Council Planning Application for Comment - SL/2023/0692 – 41 Whinfell Drive, Kendal – Single storey rear extension forming self contained annex accommodation - Amended Plan

To consider an amended plan received by Westmorland and Furness Council in relation to Planning Application No. SL/2023/0692 (the scheme has been reduced in size). The Committee is asked, therefore, to re-consider and remove its original objection to the proposal of 16 October 2023 (*The development was characterised as having the appearance of a shipping container in a garden. The Committee felt it was out of keeping with the surrounding area, of an inappropriate scale and dominance, with inappropriate design and materials. There was also concern that it would be very visible from Garburn Road. The Committee welcomed the proposal to plant silver birches, but otherwise could not support the proposal and therefore recommended refusal.).* 

 Westmorland and Furness Council Planning Applications for Comment -SL/2023/0527, 0528 & 0596 – Wainwrights Yard, Kendal

To consider amendments to the application received by Westmorland and Furness Council in relation to Planning Applications Nos. SL/2023/0527, SL/2023/0528 and SL/2023/0596. In discussions with Westmorland and Furness Council's Planning Officer and Conservation Officer, the proposed scheme has been amended (the new plans should be made available for viewing on the Westmorland and Furness Planning Portal later this week). The key amendments have included:

- Reduction in signage within the passageways, particularly removal within the northern listed passageway.
- Reduction in the size of the first floor vertical banner.
- Flush lettering and static lighting band on the ground floor vertical sign.
- Agreement to slate flooring by the conservation officer.

As such, the Town Council's Planning Committee is asked to review these amendments and to seek to remove its original objections to the applications, which can be viewed using this <u>link</u>.

## **Public Participation**

Messrs F and M Pennington, accompanied by Mr P Winter (the developers) made a brief representation on the principles behind their Planning Application SL/2023/0781. They explained that a similar application had been made in 2017 but had been rejected by the local planning authority at the time. Several amendments had been made, and there was a new development on the site opposite which altered the sites relationship with the surrounding town. The low density of the proposed development afforded the opportunity to considerably improve the biodiversity of the site. In response to queries from the developers explained the SUDS scheme for the site and the design principles. The application was for outline consent for self-build dwellings, so would not be so tightly prescriptive as to preclude innovation, but there would be protections in place to prevent overdevelopment, subdivision and design not in accordance with the site's sensitive location on the edge of the Lake District National Park and World Heritage Site.

The Committee went on to consider the application and the result is recorded in the later minute.

Prior to the formal commencement of the meeting, a minutes' silence was observed in memory of Mrs S Blackman, wife of Cllr A Blackman, whose funeral had been held earlier in the day.

The Committee had had no specific budget lines to deal with training support, and the need for some work on Neighbourhood Planning (as yet to be determined) suggested that it was prudent to bring in budget lines for these.
